

## **NEW JERSEY BREEDERS REMINDER: REBATE PROGRAM FOR PACING STALLIONS**

**MANALAPAN, NJ – June 16, 2015 –**The Standardbred Breeders & Owners Association of New Jersey wishes to remind breeders of its rebate program of up to \$100,000 for 2015 breeding fees for pacing stallions standing in the State of New Jersey.

The New Jersey Pacing Stallion Breeding Incentive offers a rebate of the full advertised stallion fee [up to \$2,500 maximum] for New Jersey resident mares and 50 percent of the stallion fee [up to a \$1,250 maximum] for non-resident mares.

The rebate will coincide with the stud fee payment.

A requirement for participation includes the nomination of the resulting foals as well as two-year-old sustaining payments for the New Jersey Sire Stakes program. The New Jersey Sire Stakes payments will be deducted from the rebate. Additionally, to be eligible, stallions must be enrolled in the USTA's STARS program.

Eligible stallions are Great Vintage and Hurrikane King Cole, who are standing at Walnridge Farm; If I Can Dream and Lis Mara, who are at Deo Volente Farm, and Philos Hanover at Last Cance Farm.
